

Joan Martin's First Grade Supply List



Below are the general supplies your child will need for first grade. Please do not label any of the items unless it says to do so. We require multiples of some items so your child will have new supplies throughout the school year.

ALL TEACHERS REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1-2 Pairs of Fiskars brand pointed scissors, labeled with your child's name
- 1 School supply box 8 x 5 size (*Zippered pencil/crayon pouch- Peeler's class*)
- Regular sized backpack (no wheels and not too small), labeled with your child's name
- 6 boxes of Crayola Crayons (box of 24)
- 10 glue sticks (no gel- we recommend Elmer's - other brands dry out quickly)
- 5 pink erasers
- 3 Packages of 24 plain yellow #2 pencils (We recommend the Papermate or Ticonderoga brand. They seem to hold up better for our first graders. Please sharpen them before school starts.)
- 5-8 black Expo dry erase markers (fat or skinny)
- 1 plain, inexpensive clipboard, labeled with your child's name.
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- A set of headphones (ear buds are acceptable also)
- 1 plastic folder
- Markers

Art Teacher requires these additional items:

- 1 box of Crayola Crayons (box of 24)
- 1 Packages of 24 plain yellow #2 pencils

*There will be a few additional items needed as well depending on your child's teacher. A list will come home the first week of school.

First grade homework will require a pencil and crayons, and occasionally scissors and glue. It is recommended that your child have these supplies at home. If this is not possible, please help me to remind your child to bring these supplies home nightly and return them to school the next day.
