## Gary Gephart Memorial Art Scholarship

Amount: One Scholarship of at least \$200

Student must be from Advanced Art classes. Must be a college-bound student seeking at least an Associate's degree in Art. Physical handicaps and financial need are also considered.

Selection will be made by the art teacher and the family of Gary Gephart

## Hobart City Democratic Precinct Organization Scholarship

Amount: Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to one male and one female.

Applicant must have qualities of good citizenship, favorable attitudes and habits, and have potential to succeed.

Selection will be made by the Precinct Organization Scholarship Committee.

## June Pangburn Nursing and Allied Health Field Scholarship

Amount: One \$1000 scholarship

Applicant must rank in the top third (1/3) of the class and must possess favorable qualities of attitude, scholarship, and citizenship, and must demonstrate a desire to study nursing or an allied health field.

Selection will be made by an independent committee appointed by the Legacy Foundation. Payment will be split between the first two semesters.

## Paul and Ruth Throne Hobart High School Student Scholarship

Amount: Two \$500 scholarships

The applicant must be a high school senior planning to attend a non-college/ university, post-secondary career training program OR a college program geared towards a service profession (fireman, policeman, cosmetologist, etc) by fall 2022.

Selection will be made by a committee designated by Hobart High School.

## Phi Beta Psi Scholarship

Amount: One \$500 scholarship

Applicants should be planning to train for a profession in a medically orientated field. Candidates will be evaluated on scholastic achievement, leadership roles, student/ community activities, and financial need. Recipients must maintain a "C" average while in college and be able to show proof of enrollment.

Selection will be made by a committee of Phi Beta Psi.

## The Sam Moore Big Heart Scholarship

Amount: Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to one male and one female athlete.

Applicants should be a true Brickie at heart and model the characteristics of trustworthiness, responsibility and citizenship. Applicants should have demonstrated resilience and dedicated effort throughout high school.

Selection will be made by a committee including the athletic director, football coach and baseball coach.

## SCOH Educational Foundation Scholarship

Amount: Two \$1,500 scholarships

Preference will be given to applicants with an intended major in education. Applicants must be actively involved in school and community activities.

Selection will be made by the SCOH Educational Foundation.

## The Steiner Kerman Education Foundation Scholarship

Amount: One \$1,500 scholarship

Applicant must be actively involved in school and community activities. Applicants must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. Financial need will weigh heavily in the selection.

## Hobart Tri Kappa High School Scholarship

Amount: Two\* \$1,500 scholarships

Applicant must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Hobart. You must be admitted as a full-time student at an accredited college, university, vocational school or junior or community college for the fall term following high school graduation. Submit two letters of recommendation - one letter from a high school teacher and one letter from a responsible community member not from your high school.

\*The second Tri Kappa scholarship may be awarded to a student from Andean - it is not guaranteed to an HHS student.

Selection will be made by a committee of Hobart Tri Kappa members.

## Hobart Tri Kappa Fine Arts Scholarship

Amount: One \$1,000 scholarship

Applicants must be pursuing fine arts at the post-secondary level in order to qualify. This scholarship will be advertised to students who attend Andean, so there is a possibility it will not be awarded to an HHS student. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Hobart. You must be admitted as a full-time student at an accredited college, university, vocational school or junior or community college for the fall term following high school graduation. Submit two letters of recommendation - one letter from a high school teacher and one letter from a responsible community member not from your high school.

Selection will be made by a committee of Hobart Tri Kappa members.

## Hobart Lions Club Scholarship

Amount: Two \$500 scholarships

Hobart Lions Club is offering 2 \$500 scholarships to graduating Hobart residents. This means it is available to students at other high schools like Andean HS. The applicant must show evidence of volunteer service to the community that fulfills the Lions motto, "We Serve". The applicant must plan to attend a college or university or other post-secondary training.

Selection will be made by a committee of Lions Club members.

## Hobart Lions Club Trade School Scholarship

Amount: One \$500 scholarship

Hobart Lions Club is offering 1 \$500 scholarships to graduating Hobart residents. This means it is available to students at other high schools like Andean HS. The Hobart Lions Club is offering a \$500 award to a

Hobart resident who is pursuing a career in the trades. Selection of student is dependent upon acceptance into a trade school, and evidence of volunteering for community service.

Selection will be made by a committee of Lions Club members.

### The Lauren Romeo *Golden Athlete* Memorial Scholarship

Amount: A \$500 scholarship is available to one male and one female

Applicant must have been an active participant on a Hobart High School sports team for at least 3 seasons. (Sports may vary.) Applicant must have demonstrated unwavering commitment to the teams, positive attitude during the seasons, solid ability to connect with teammates, and determination to work hard to balance academics and athletics. Applicant must carry a GPA of at least 3.5 and must be admitted full-time to an accredited college, university or trade school for the fall term following high school graduation. Applicant will be required to submit a one-page essay.

\*\*Preference will be given to multi-year/multi-sport athletes.

\*\*This scholarship will be awarded IN ADDITION to any scholarship awarded from the Local Scholarship Book.

Selection will be made thru conferences with coaches and the Romeo family.

### Important Notes about the Local Scholarship Book:

\*Scholarship applications are chosen in order of the highest scholarship amount. Once a student is chosen as a recipient, their application is withdrawn from all other selections on the chart. **Students can only win one scholarship from the Local Scholarship Book (with the exception of the Lauren Romeo *Golden Athlete* Memorial Scholarship).**

\*\*All scholarships are a one-time award and will not be renewed.

\*\*\*All scholarship winners will be announced at the Senior Honors Convocation on May 31, 2022 at 6 pm

\*\*\*\*All applicants should have applied, or been accepted to, a college/university or trade prior to submitting this application.
